Excursion to Jungfraujoch. Wednesday, September 8

The **Jungfraujoch** excursion is one of the most interesting popular tourist destinations in Switzerland. With a length of over 6071m, the **Grindelwald-Männlichen** Gondola Cableway is the worlds longest aerial gondola. **Jungfraujoch** railway station, which at an elevation of 3454 meters is the highest railway station in Europe. The **Jungfraujoch** is often called the **"Top of Europe"**.

The excursion schedule:

- 1. 12:00 walk from the hotel to the **Grund station** (about 15min)
- 2. 12:15 take a cable car from Grund to Maennlichen (about 30min, destination height 2230m)
- 3. 13:00-14:30 walk from Maennlichen to Kleine Scheidegg (about 1.5hour, destination height 2061m)
- 4. 15:00 take the mountain train from Kleine Scheidegg to Jungfraujoch (about 50min, destination 3454m)
- 5. 18:30 take the train back to **Grindelwald**.

The standard cost of such a trip is 160SFr. We have got a group discount and we compensate a part of the cost by the funds available from the sponsoring companies, but we cannot cover the full cost. Therefore we ask the participants who join us for this excursion to contribute **50SFr** (to be paid in cash at the Workshop registration desk).

We have to know in advance how many people will participate in this excursion. If you did not register yet but wish to participate, please do it not later than **Monday**, **September 6** at our secretariat. Also be aware that the number of places for the organized excursion at the reduced price is limited!

If you are going to participate please take with you **proper shoes and clothes**. Temperature at 2000m could be around +10C, at 3400m it will be very likely below 0C (certainly in the Ice Palace). If somebody does not want to hike from **Männlichen** to **Kleine Scheidegg** there is a possibility to take a train from **Grindelwald to Kleine Scheidegg** and wait for the main group there (nice hiking area, shops, bars and restaurants). There will be no lunch at the Hotel therefore a lunch box will be given out to everyone before the excursion.
